The first public showing of an 8½-foot-high scale model of the World Trade Center-Hudson and Manhattan project will be featured as part of The Port of New York Authority's exhibit at the 6th Annual United States World Trade Fair, May 11-22, 1962, at the New York Coliseum.

REPORTERS AND PHOTOGRAPHERS ARE CORDIALLY INVITED TO VIEW THE MODEL DURING THE PRESS PREVIEW OF THE FAIR, ON THURSDAY, MAY 10, FROM 2:00 P.M. TO 5:00 P.M., IN BOOTH 405, SECOND FLOOR (AT THE HEAD OF THE ESCALATORS).

The model has cut-away sections to show interior areas, including rehabilitated H&M Terminal facilities. A two-minute telephone-tape conversation between a businessman from India and World Trade Center information agents, coordinated with lights in the model, describes to listeners on 14 telephones how the Center will assist the International businessman and facilitate his export-import transactions.
